## BEFORE COMING TO WEE CARE:

As we continue to navigate the ongoing global pandemic, parents and caregivers should screen with the questions below prior to bringing children.

#### You should NOT come into the building if...

- 1. You have a fever of 100 degrees or higher.
- 2. You are experiencing new sore throat or cough symptoms or new difficulty breathing.
- 3. You have diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain, or new onset of headache, especially with fever.
- 4. You have had close contact with a person with a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis.

Please use your best judgement. If you are questioning whether your child is well, we kindly ask you to play it safe and keep them home until they are symptom free and ready to return to our care.

## PICK UP & DROP OFF

#### **DROP OFF PROCEDURES:**

- Parent/guardian enters building using center door to main entrance \*look for Welcome flags\*
- At this time, masks are not required but we will have them available for those who choose to wear one
- Parent will check in at preschool desk
- DROP OFF TIMES in classroom are from 8:55a 9:15a.
- Please say goodbye from the classroom door and avoid lingering in the classroom and hallways
- Exit out 'Emergency Exit' to First St. after drop off
- AFTER 9:15am the Preschool Entrance will be locked & you will need to call/ring the doorbell for entry

### PICK UP PROCEDURES:

- Pick up begins at 2:10pm // all children are to be picked up promptly by 2:30pm
- At this time, masks are not required but we will have them available for those who choose to wear one
- Parent/guardian enter and remain in foyer
- Check out on iPads in the foyer
- Your child and his/her belongings will be brought to you

## **PLANS & PROCEDURES**

- If your child who is in our care becomes ill with Covid-19, please let us know immediately. You can call or text Becca (936.676.3148)
- If we are made known of a positive case for a current child or staff member, we will let those who have been in contact (the child's room) know
- If you have been in direct contact or have someone in your household with a positive case, PLEASE KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME.
- In the event that we have a large outbreak, we may have to close one room or our facility for a period of time. This is a LAST RESORT! We pray that through our collective diligence of not bringing ill people (children, staff, parents, etc..) into our preschool, we can continue operations!
